Paseo Bridge Reopened to Traffic

Repair work finished nine days earlier than anticipated

KANSAS CITY, MO – All lanes on Interstate 29/35 at the Paseo Bridge are now open to traffic in both directions. Repairs were made following an expansion joint failure on the Paseo Bridge on Saturday, August 22.

“We realize this has been an inconvenience to motorists” said MoDOT Project Director, Brian Kidwell.

“The contractor has done a great job, and we are pleased to have these urgent repairs finished so quickly.

Now we can continue to focus on building the new bridge.”

The \$245 million kcICON project will reconstruct/rehabilitate 4.7 miles of Interstate 29/35 from just north of Route 210/Armour Road in North Kansas City into the northeast corner of the downtown Kansas City, Mo. freeway loop. The project includes improving outdated interchanges and the construction of the Christopher S. Bond Bridge – a new landmark, cable-stay Missouri River bridge.
