Traffic Switch on Southbound Interstate 29/35 Tomorrow

NORTH KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Southbound traffic on Interstate 29/35, from just north of Armour Road to 16th Avenue, will be shifted to outside lanes starting at 8:30 a.m. Thursday, May 27, 2010. This work will continue throughout the day, likely affecting evening rush hour. Southbound interstate traffic will be reduced to one lane at times, during this work. This traffic configuration will be in effect until fall 2010.

“Workers will be setting protective concrete barrier and shifting traffic in order to complete new pavement work on the inside lanes of the interstate,” said kcICON Project Director Brian Kidwell. “In a few weeks we will be able to open the new on-ramp from eastbound Armour Road to southbound I-29/35. The crews on this project are working hard to meet or beat our project completion deadline of July 2011.”

The current right lane closure for southbound I-29/35, just north of the Armour Road exit ramp, will be changed to a left lane closure for interstate motorists as part of this traffic shift. The posted speed limit will remain 45 mph. kcICON Project team members ask that motorists continue to take other routes and consider alternative modes of transportation to alleviate traffic congestion, when possible.
