Southbound Interstate 35 to Paseo Boulevard Ramp to Close June 3 *Ramp will remain closed until summer 2010 as a new entrance ramp is built under the roadway*

KANSAS CITY, MO – The southbound exit ramp 4A from Interstate 35 to Paseo Boulevard and Independence Avenue will close Wednesday June 3, 2009 for approximately one year.

This closure will allow grading work to begin under the Paseo ramp roadway, as the new access ramp to northbound I-35 is built. The new northbound ramp is scheduled to be completed by fall of 2010.

The marked detour will move motorists along Interstate 35 to the Oak/Grand/Walnut Street exit and take the Oak St. exit ramp up to Admiral Boulevard. At the light, motorists will turn east onto Admiral Boulevard and take Admiral to Paseo Boulevard, turning north to reach Independence Avenue/Route 24. For motorists taking the southbound alternate Missouri River route from Burlington Avenue/Route 9, they will continue south to Admiral Boulevard, and turn east to Paseo Boulevard, then north to reach the Independence Avenue intersection. Detour map is attached.

The \$245 million kcICON project will reconstruct/rehabilitate 4.7 miles of Interstate 29/35 from just north of Route 210/Armour Road in North Kansas City into the northeast corner of the downtown Kansas City, Mo. freeway loop. The project includes improving outdated interchanges and the construction of the Christopher S. Bond Bridge – a new landmark, cable-stay Missouri River Bridge.
